Available Certifications:

American Red Cross Emergency Medical Response Certification

Students receive training in basic and advanced first aid procedures including patient assessment, medical emergencies, trauma emergencies, wound care, airway management and scene safety procedures.

Student Cost: 17.00

American Red Cross CPR/AED Certification

Students learn how to provide cardio-pulmonary resuscitation to adults, children and infants. They also learn how to use protective face shields, bag-valve masks and how to administer oxygen to a patient in a breathing crisis event.

Student Cost: 17.00

Unarmed Defensive Training Certification

Students will learn how to defend themselves using non-deadly defense techniques against a physical attack by another individual while only using the minimal amount of force needed to stop the attacker.

Student Cost: Free

Less Than Lethal Weapons Training Certification

Students will learn how to use defensive chemical spray (Pepper Spray Techniques) against an attacker: human or animal. Control of the attacker is the primary concept of this valuable non-lethal training.
